Monday Check-In:

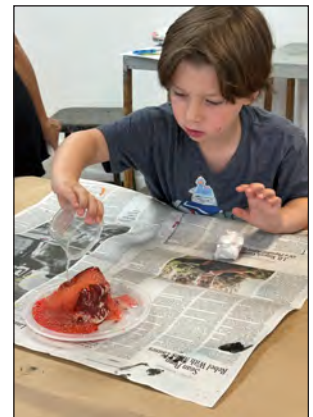
When you arrive on your child's first day of Summer Art Studios, ***all students MUST check-in at the tent located in front of the main school building every week.*** Please have forms ready to be checked by a staff member upon arrival.

A Lunch Bunch Experience:

Enrollment in this program IS NOT automatic. You must call the office if you would like to enroll your child.

A Lunch Bunch Experience is available free of charge to campers participating in a ***full-day of camp only***. Students participating in a half-day camp may enroll in the lunch period for a fee of \$125, if spots are available. ***Priority registration is given to full day campers.*** Decisions regarding availability will be made 1 week before the program start date.

Lunch Bunch will be held in an outdoor setting allowing campers to eat lunch in a safe and supervised environment. If there is rain, students will eat indoors. Children will be able to have lunch, engage in free draw, small art projects and board games during the hour. The campers will be escorted to and from their lunch period by a camp assistant. Campers should bring a nut-free lunch and something to drink.
